





About the Summer 2017 Internship Program

Selected student interns will participate in the summer internship program for approximately 6 weeks, a total of 120 hours. Students will be paid minimum wage of \$12.00 per hour for the duration of the internship. Students are expected to participate in all of the soft-skills training prior to the internship program and are expected to fully participate for the duration of the internship. Students are expected to provide their own transportation to and from the internship.
