

#### AM I GOING TO GET GRADED ON THIS?


Yes, so pay attention to the instructions

- We are going to be folding on the Long Edge







#### STEP 3 - ORIGAMI...

1 ½


• Fold about an  $1\frac{1}{2}$  on the long edge  $\frac{1\frac{1}{2}}{2}$ 






#### STEP 4 - ORIGAMI...

 Fold the larger section from the first fold in ½ along the the long edge







### STEP 5 - ORIGAMI...

Make a Triangle

Put First and Last name on both sides
